## REMEMBERING Dr. John Melvin



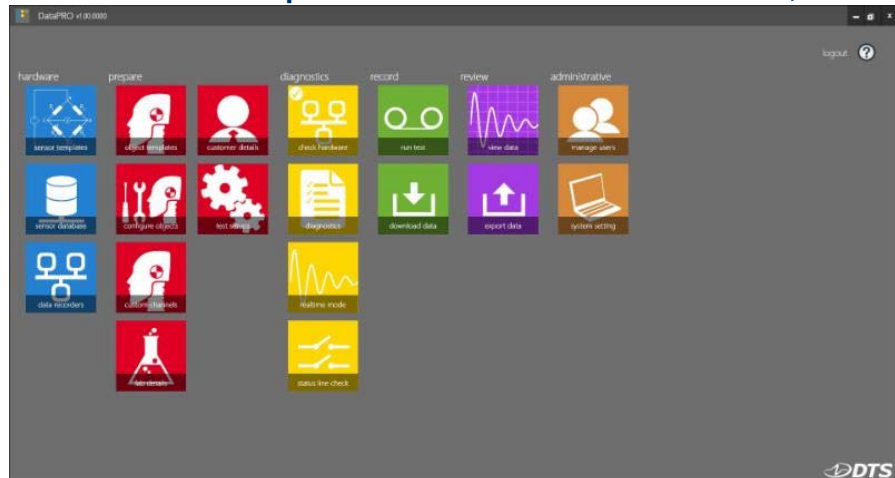
Few people have had such an impact on motorsports safety as Dr. John Melvin.
