SLICE™ collects data during world record jump

13 October 2009

Professor Splash sets new world record, diving from 35' 9" into 12" of water!

DTS SLICE data recorder along with 5 accelerometers strapped to Professor Splash's back and a pressure pad mounted to his chest successfully achieved the status of holding the current world record for shallow dives. Professor Splash leaped from a diving platform 35 feet 9 inches above the ground into just 12 inches of water contained in a small inflatable pool. A thunderous roar from 12,000 spectators was heard throughout the stadium when Professor Splash bounced to his feet in a victorious salute.

DTS SLICE DAS was recording for a total of 33 minutes at 5000 samples per second on a 9.6V battery. The dive lasted 22 minutes.
